Cobham Hall

HOW TO REACH US BY ROAD, RAIL AND AIR

BY ROAD: Cobham Hall is situated adjacent to the A2/M2, 8 miles east of M25 Junction 2, between Gravesend and Rochester. We are within 10 minutes drive from Ebbsfleet International station and the Bluewater shopping centre, and within 1 hours drive from the ports of Folkestone and Dover.

You will find detailed directions by road overleaf, together with a local map.

Please note that SatNav directions will take you down Lodge Lane, just outside Cobham village, from which there is no access to Cobham Hall. When you leave the A2 or come through Cobham village, **ignore your SatNav instructions** and follow the directions below.

BY RAIL: Nearest Stations:

Ebbsfleet (*10 minutes from Cobham Hall*)

London (St Pancras) - 17 minutes

Meopham (*10 minutes from Cobham Hall*)

London (Victoria) - 45 minutes

Gravesend (*15 minutes from Cobham Hall*)

London (Charing Cross/Waterloo) - 40 minutes

There is a taxi rank at all railway stations. National Rail enquiries: 08457 484950

BY EUROSTAR TO EUROPE:

Ebbsfleet International (*10 minutes from Cobham Hall*) - just over 2 hours to Paris

Ashford International (*45 minutes from Cobham Hall*) - Paris in under 2 hours

Folkestone Terminal (*1 hour's drive from Cobham Hall*)

BY AIR: Gatwick and Stansted airports – within 30 minutes' drive
Heathrow and London City airports – within 1 hour's drive
All the above times are approximate.

On Arrival: Come down the drive and through the archway into the main car park where there are reserved parking spaces for visitors immediately on the left.

Reception is the door on your right as you walk back to the archway.

BY ROAD TO COBHAM HALL

Please note that SatNav directions will take you down Lodge Lane, just outside Cobham village, from which there is no access to Cobham Hall. When you leave the A2 or come through Cobham village, ignore your SatNav instruction and follow the directions below.

From London

Travel South East on the A2, signposted Canterbury and Dover. From the junction with the M25 (Junction 2), pick up the A2 coastbound directions below.

M25

If you are approaching by the M25, you should leave the motorway at Junction 2 (south of the Dartford Crossing), join the **A2 coastbound** and follow the directions below.

A2 Coastbound (Dover)

Following the A2 coastbound, you will pass the A227 exit, signposted Gravesend, and just a short way further on, the Inn on the Lake on your left. The road starts to rise here and just over the top you should take the exit signposted to Cobham.

Turn left at the T junction at the end of the sliproad, still signposted to Cobham. The road crosses over the A2, and the entrance to the Hall is on your left, immediately before the roundabout.

M2/A2 Westbound (London)

After crossing the Medway Bridge, continue towards London, joining the A2. Take the exit signposted Cobham. At the roundabout take the first exit and you will see the entrance to Cobham Hall immediately on your right.

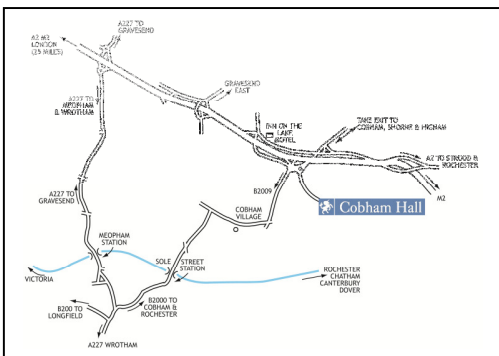
M20 Westbound (London)

If you are approaching by the M20, you should leave the motorway at Junction 3 (the M26 connection) signposted A20 and A227 Gravesend. Take the 3rd exit from the roundabout at the end of the sliproad, on to the A20, following signs for the A227 Gravesend. At the next roundabout take the second exit, still signposted to the A227, and at the next roundabout (at the top of a long, straight hill, take the 2nd exit, joining the A227 – signposted to Gravesend and Meopham.

Follow the A227 through Culverstone and into Meopham. You will pass Meopham Green on your right, then Meopham School on your left and St John's church on your right. The road bends right here and there is a parade of shops on your left. Immediately after the parade of shops, turn right into Green Lane – signposted to Cobham. Follow this B road through Sole Street until you reach the T Junction, with the National Trust property of Owletts in front of you. Turn right and drive through Cobham village, where there are serious traffic calming measures! Turn left at the mini roundabout at the far end of the village.

Follow this road out of the village until you reach the roundabout. Take the 3rd exit, signposted A2 Rochester. The entrance to the Hall is immediately on your right.
