AN EDUCATION FOR LIFE

A Cobham Hall education is an education for life. Alongside academic results, our students leave with the skills universities and employers look for: skills in complex problem-solving, project and time management, critical thinking, and creativity; resilience, teamwork, and compassion. Almost all go on to university, some following highly academic routes, such as study at Oxbridge and Russell Group institutes, while others opt for more vocational courses. All are happy, motivated, and considerate: empowered to be the best they can be, secure in the knowledge they are equipped for an ever-changing future and fully prepared to embrace the challenges ahead.

AN ENHANCED A LEVEL CURRICULUM

Cobham Hall School achieves consistently good academic results. In 2023, 81% of grades achieved were A* to C, with a 100% pass rate. An astonishing 90% of students were offered places at their first choice universities - a remarkable achievement for a non-selective school, with all securing places at top UK universities.

Alongside a broad range of A Levels, the school offers a unique enrichment programme, aimed at enhancing Sixth Formers' intellectual curiosity and creativity. All follow our unique Global Critical Thinking and Perspectives course and study the EPQ (Extended Project Qualification), much loved by universities. Cobham Hall has also recently introduced the Future Perspectives course which aims to equip Year 12 and 13 students with essential life skills and self-awareness to prepare them for their future.

LIFE IN OUR CO-EDUCATIONAL SIXTH FORM

INNOVATION, CHALLENGE, INTERNATIONALISM

Cobham Hall School has been in the vanguard of education since it opened in 1962: a place of innovation and challenge. The first UK girls’ school to join the global Round Square network, Cobham Hall has long stood for internationalism and modern Round Square values of democracy, environmentalism, adventure, leadership, and service. Its alumnae are, not surprisingly, at the forefront of the arts, science, medicine, politics, and sport, and include Olympic Gold-winner Kate French, BBC journalist and broadcaster Mishal Husain, and Baroness Kate Fall, member of the UK’s House of Lords.



Though girls and boys have separate boarding accommodation, they learn together. We know the tremendous benefits of a single sex education in a child’s formative years: we also understand the challenges that transfer to university life increasingly brings. While Cobham Hall will remain girls-only from years 7 to 11, we believe the co-educational bridge our Sixth Form offers best prepares the students of today for the realities of 21st century life.

Outside the classroom, girls and boys have the opportunity to develop teamwork skills as they take part together in co-curricular programmes such as the Duke of Edinburgh’s Award Scheme and Model United Nations. In sport, students pursue activities such as tennis, swimming, badminton, hockey, cricket, running, football and basketball in mixed teams, with further sports available through liaison with local specialist clubs.

Working together, learning together, socialising together, within our safe, secure and supportive environment, Cobham Hall boys and girls gain the skills and mutual understanding they need to thrive.

INSPIRING SURROUNDINGS

Famously set in 150 acres of beautiful parkland, Cobham Hall’s historic building saw the opening of a stunning new Sixth Form Centre in September. Housed in glorious rooms built to entertain Queen Elizabeth I, the Centre’s modern layout and furnishings are ideally suited to 21st century education. Their décor has been strongly influenced by the ideas of our student body, encouraged, as always, to play a leadership role.



A NEW ERA OF DEVELOPMENT

Since becoming part of The Mill Hill School Foundation in 2021, Cobham Hall has embarked upon a major, long-term programme of development. Recent improvements include conversion to environmentally friendly biomass heating and refurbishment of our sports hall and boarding accommodation, as well as the creation of our new Sixth Form Centre. Upcoming developments include a remodelling of our swimming centre, and the installation of a new sports ground and Astro Turf.
